Frequently asked questions (FAQ) about QB Convention 2010

PASTORS' & SPOUSES' CONFERENCE (10 - 12 MAY 2010)

- Q:** *I am a Pastor registering for the Pastors' & Spouses' (P&S) Conference at Mt Tamborine. Does my \$200/pp registration package include all Convention events?*
- A:** Your registration includes attendance at the MTQ workshops but does not include events at Reedy Creek Baptist Church. You need to indicate on the registration form that you will also be attending these events which include the GlobalInteraction and MTQ Dinners, the Prayer Breakfast, Business Day, Saturday Seminars and neoLeader.
- Q:** *I have registered for P&S. Do I need to register and pay for the MTQ Workshops as well?*
- A:** You do need to register so that we know who plans to attend.
You do not need to pay. Your P&S registration cost covers the cost of attending.
- Q:** *I note child minding is offered at P&S for children under 5 yrs. Can I bring my older children?*
- A:** Where at all possible, we encourage you to make other arrangements for your older children so that the conference can be a time of spiritual and physical refreshment for you and your spouse. If you are unable to do so, please contact Pat Kingham rpkingham@bigpond.com to discuss your needs.
- Q:** *My husband and I have a small toddler. Can we be accommodated as a family unit?*
- A:** This may not be possible if more people register than can be accommodated in family groups, however every effort will be made to meet your request. People with medical conditions are given priority for private space.
- Q:** *We will be staying offsite but attending P&S Conference sessions. How do we register for day attendance with all meals including dinner?*
- A:** Please select day only registration plus dinner only option for the days you plan to attend. This booking selection is available online. If sending hard copy registration (mail or fax), please specify your needs on separate paper.
- Q:** *We want to attend the Appreciation Dinner (formerly Blessings Banquet) and stay overnight but that's all we are able to attend. How do we register and what will bed and breakfast (Wednesday overnight) cost?*
- A:** Overnight Wednesday night (B&B) cost is \$35/pp. This booking selection is available online. If sending hard copy registration (mail or fax), please tick Dinner, B&B option for Wednesday and calculate cost as \$35/pp. Your RSVP to the Appreciation Dinner is also requested for catering.
- Q:** *I'm new to the area. I'd like to use my GPS to find the camp site.*
- A:** Key in North Tamborine. If you key Mt Tamborine, you'll end up at the wrong place!

Q: *Is linen supplied by the Tamborine Camp Site?*

A: No, you will need to bring your sheets, blankets/duonas, pillows/pillow cases and towels. For added comfort, you may also wish to bring mattress protectors. All beds are single.

Q: *We would like to continue to stay at QCCC at Mt Tamborine so that we can attend the Reedy Creek events. Is this possible?*

Q: *What is the travelling time by car from QCCC at Mt Tamborine to Reedy Creek Baptist Church and is transport arranged for transit to and from?*
